They also help building owners meet the requirements of Part M and the Equality Act (DDA).

### Midilift SL

A conventional, economical platform lift. It is hydraulically driven and can travel up to 5 metres. The platform is operated by easy-to-use constant pressure controls and moves safely within its own shaft. Finishes are available to complement surrounding decor. It solves small access problems in your building simply, making a huge difference to its users.

### Midilift XLplus

A traction driven platform lift with a partially enclosed cabin which moves safely within its own shaft. Because it can have automatic controls, it feels more like a traditional passenger lift. It can travel up to 12m at 0.15m/s at the touch of a button. The efficient drive system is incorporated within the lift enclosure, meaning no motor room or cabinet. Shafts and cabins can be part or fully glazed. A wide range of finishes will complement surrounding décor or can match existing lifts within your building. If your building cannot accommodate a fully automatic passenger lift, this is an ideal alternative.

# Midilift finishes

All our vertical platform lifts are supplied in a hard wearing and practical powder coated finish in RAL 9002 (grey white) as standard.

Alternative RAL colours are available as an option – please contact us for details.

The structure-supported enclosure is supplied with powder coated steel infill panels as standard, with glass infill panels available as an option.

The integral cabin handrail is supplied in satin stainless steel. Landing doors are two panel glazed as standard.

## Midilift SL cabin finishes

Platform floors are finished in hard wearing grey vinyl, with wood effect vinyl available as an option. We can also leave the platform floor for finishing by others.

## Midilift XLplus cabin finishes

The cabin is available in a number of standard finishes or can be customised to suit. It is supplied with a suspended downlighter effect ceiling as standard, with a halogen downlighter ceiling available as an option.

There are two levels of finishes – **Style** and **Custom**.



### Style

Style cabin walls and control panel are finished in hard wearing vinyl skin plate – three colour options are available as standard (light grey, light blue or cream). The ceiling is powder coated white as standard. Please see separate finishes sheet for other options available.



















### Custom

The Custom cabin offers a greater degree of flexibility, allowing you to personalise the lift car finish to your individual requirements. The car walls can be finished in a range of wallboards or mirrors. Alternatively, the walls can be supplied as glass panels to complement a glass structure.

# Midilift XLplus cabin finishes

The cabin car can be supplied in one of three standard **Style** colour options, or two standard **Custom** options, which include stainless steel finishes and coloured wallboards or glass walls to complement a glass structure. They can also be customised to suit – see all finish options on right.
